

# Wave Scarf

*The interesting texture of this scarf is made possible by the fact that Berroco makes Ultra Alpaca and Ultra Alpaca Fine in matching colors.*



**Yarn:** 1 skein Berroco “Ultra Alpaca” and 1 skein Berroco “Ultra Alpaca Fine” in the same color.

**Needles:** US 8

**Gauge:** 17 sts = 4 in

**Finished Size:** Approx. 53 in x 7 in (to make a longer scarf you will need two skeins of Ultra Alpaca)

**Pattern Notes:** As long as you work the correct number of rows in each yarn, you will not need to cut it and re-start. The yarn will be waiting on the side where you need it. When carrying yarn up the side, be careful not to pull it so tight that the edge gathers.

## Instructions:

CO 30 sts with both yarns held together.  
Knit 3 rows with both yarns held together.  
Drop the Fingering (F), knit 2 rows with Worsted (W) only.  
Drop W, knit 4 rows with F only.

Begin repeated sequence as follows:

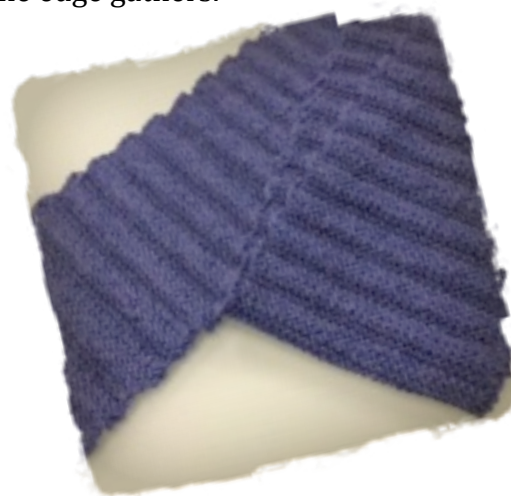
Knit 2 rows with W only.  
Knit 2 rows holding W and F together.  
Knit 2 rows with W only.  
Knit 4 rows with F only.

Repeat these 10 rows until you are almost out of W or scarf is about 52 in long, ending after the 4 F rows.

Work end of scarf as follows:

Knit 2 rows with W only.  
Knit 3 rows holding W and F together.  
BO holding W and F together.

NOTE: For an infinity scarf version, sew the CO and BO edges together.



**Key:** BO=bind off; CO=cast on; in = inch; st=stitch
